Only a qualified person on the specific make and model of the Hydro Mobile equipment is allowed to perform maintenance inspections and repairs on Hydro Mobile units according to the guidelines, instructions, warnings and methods set out in the owner's manuals and Hydro Mobile training courses.  It is recommended to use replacement parts manufactured by or recommended by Hydro Mobile. The use of substitution parts could not only void the warranty covering this motorized unit and its components but cause serious damages that could lead to injury or death. It is recommended to replenish and grease components only with fluids and lubricants recommended by Hydro Mobile.  Annual inspections must be performed by a qualified technician (see above).
